Directions to the Shooting Venue Bill Morris Park ~ Soccer Complex Sunset Blvd Jesup, GA 31545

From Brunswick: Coming into Jesup on Hwy 341, turn left on Hwy 301.
Go about 2-3 miles and turn right on Sunset Blvd. After crossing the second
set of railroad tracks, go about another 1-2 miles. Bill Morris Park will be
on your left. Turn left on Hinson Mosely Rd. At the left curve, turn left
following signs to the Soccer Field.

From Savannah: Coming into Jesup on Hwy 84 and Hwy 301, stay on Hwy 84. Go
just about all the through Jesup. After you pass KFC, go about 1 mile. Turn left on
Hinson Mosely Rd. At the right curve, turn right following signs to Soccer Field.

From Baxley: Coming into Jesup on Hwy 341, turn right on Joey Williamson Rd.
You will proceed to pass the High School on your left. Joey Williamson Rd will
cross over Hwy 84 and become Hinson Mosley Rd. At left curve, turn left
following signs to Soccer Field.

2005 GEORGIA GranPrix

INFORMATION SHEET

The Georgia Grand Prix is an individual match tournament of head-to-head competition, known as an "OLYMPIC" Round, and a Team Round. It is open to all competitors in the Georgia Target Championships. It is a separate event, and is not required for the Championships. There are no extra fees, and awards will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places in each division.

Out-of-state guests will compete in the same divisions as GA archers.

THE TEAM ROUND WILL BE SHOT ON SATURDAY, FOLLOWING THE SCORING OF THE LONGER DISTANCES OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

In the team round, teams of three combine scores in competition against another team. Registration for Teams will be taken on Sat. during the scoring of the championships.

The Team round will be shot at 50 meters, on the 122cm face.

Team divisions are COMPOUND and RECURVE.

Teams of 3 archers may be made up of of any ages, male or female.

The team event will be by Elimination. Each team of three archers will be given 3 minutes to shoot 9 arrows, 3 arrows per team member, for three ends. 27 arrows total per team. The winning team will advance to the next match. A ranking match will be held first and then we will cut to the top 8 teams in each division for elimination matches. The team round should take approximately 2 hours.

THE INDIVIDUAL ROUND WILL BE SHOT ON SUNDAY FOLLOWING THE SCORING OF THE SHORTER DISTANCES OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP.

The Olympic round will be at 70 meters, on the 122cm face.

In the individual round, Archers will compete in one-on-one matches, 18 or 12 arrows per match, with the winning archer advancing to the next level.

For individual match competition, divisions will be:

Female Recurve & Male Recurve, Female Compound & Male Compound.
