

2016 Annual Meeting Minutes

February 28, 2016, Boots Ward Recreation Center, Lost Mountain Park

Attendance:

- 28 KAC individual and family memberships in attendance and 9 non-KAC members in attendance

Meeting called to order by KAC president, John Weaver Francis at 6:15

Opening Statements: John Weaver Francis

- A successful year for the club.
- Two indoor tournaments were held at Jim Miller Park, The next indoor tournament is November 2016
- The club has now recouped the expense for the 10 target assemblies purchased for tournaments
- More targets have been purchased from a club that is closing
- Two field tournaments will be held this summer, announcement re: field range volunteering to come soon
- Last indoor session will be Sunday, April 28, first outdoor session will be Saturday, March 5

Indoor Tournaments: Jeff Powelson

October 31 and November 1, 2015

- 2-day, 3 sessions total
- 4 family entries and 78 individual entries, 30 adults and 54 JOAD archers
- Total revenue (tournament fees and concessions): \$2085

January 1, 2016

- 1-day, 3 back-to-back sessions giving families more opportunity to participate
- 11 family entries and 67 individual archers, 30 adult and 52 JOAD
- Total revenue (tournament fees and concessions): \$1775

Orientation: Pat Bowen (reported by John Weaver Francis)

- Pat Bowen has taken over the job of orientation coordinator and head orientation coach.
- Indoor sessions have been successful.
- Changes to the way outdoor sessions are organized will be announced.

Membership and Communications: Mary Meacham

- KAC has 97 full memberships and 14 JOAD/AAP only memberships (^ from last year's numbers)
- All emails are now done through USA Archery. All members are encouraged to update their email address with USA Archery. Members are encouraged to check Facebook or email if there are session questions.
- SMS Text Messaging is being researched as a way of communications. We will need to purchase into an online system so that a member's individual phone number is not used. This will give all officers the ability to send out texts to those members who register to use the service (no charge to members). It will also allow recipients to reply to texts without spamming the sender's inbox. Similar services are used by Cobb County Schools (Remind101) and many businesses.
- T-shirts: Call for volunteers to design, research, order club t-shirts. Cost needs to be no more than \$15
- Team shirts: were very popular. Will need to research new vendor.

- Tina and John Biggins were nominated and elected (by unanimous vote) to fill the Treasurer position as co-treasurers.
